JAMAICA'S LATEST EXPORTS

Thanks in large part to the reopening of **Goldeneye** (goldeneye.com; doubles from \$672), this Caribbean isle has been making waves, but you can experience its rich flavor without hopping on a plane. Now on iPods everywhere: the **Jolly Boys**, whose shuffling mento rhythm and twangy banjo evoke Jamaica's movie-star days—after all, the band did entertain Errol Flynn there in the 1950's. The septuagenarians are back this month with **Great Expectation** (Geejam Recordings), an album of covers (Amy Winehouse's "Rehab"; Johnny Cash's "Ring of Fire") recorded at the Geejam Hotel, near Port Antonio. Listen to their tracks over slow-grilled jerk chicken and ginger beer at **Miss Lily's** (132 W. Houston St.; 646/588-5375; dinner for two \$76), in New York City; the restaurant was just opened by Paul Salmon, co-owner of Negril's Rockhouse hotel.—PETER J. FRANK
