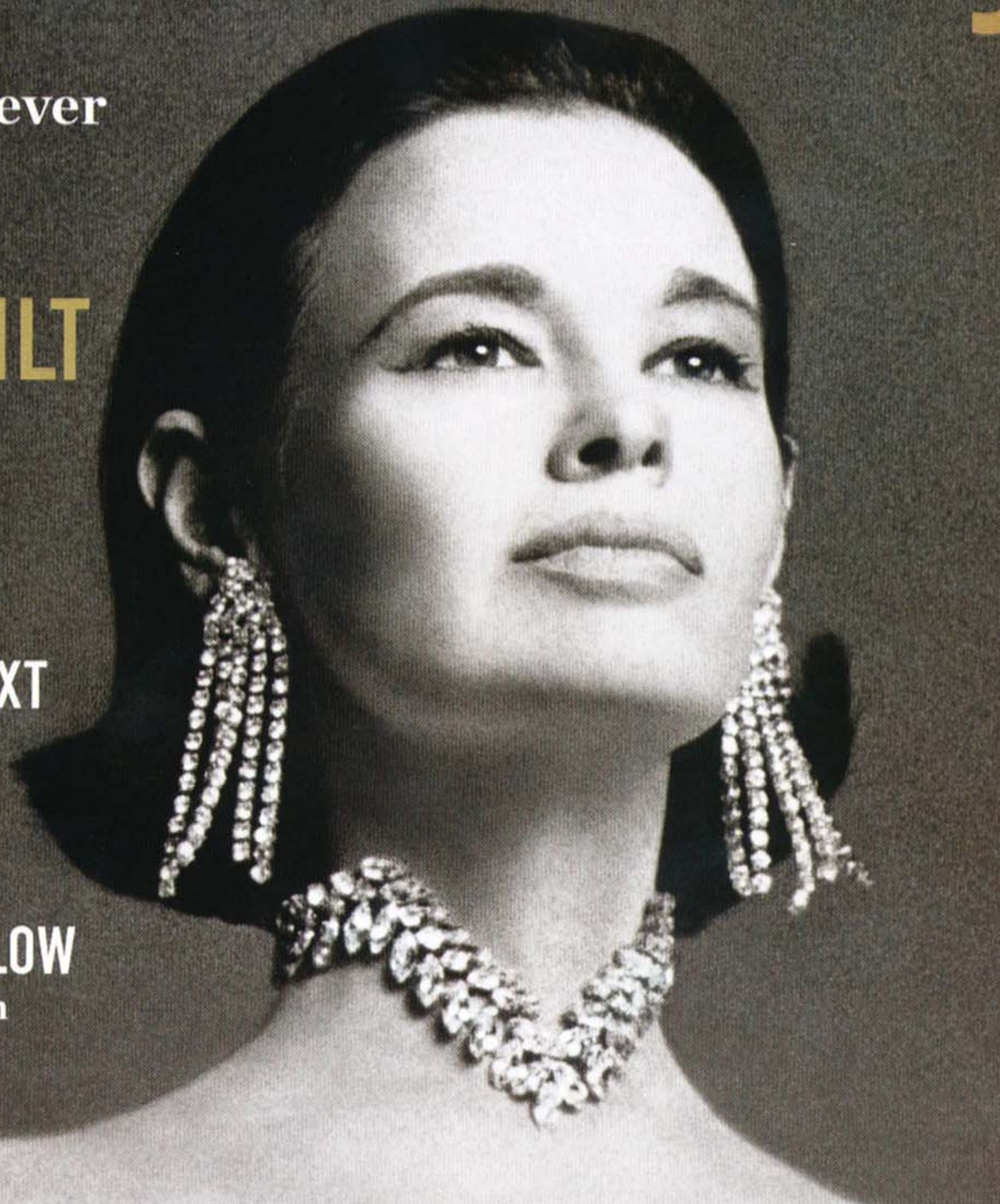

THE HOTEL

GoldenEye Hotel & Resort, Jamaica

BECAUSE: Who *doesn't* have a secret James Bond fantasy? Live it out at **GoldenEye Hotel & Resort**, the fifty-two-acre Jamaican estate where author Ian Fleming wrote all fourteen Bond novels. Backed by tropical gardens and fronted by the clear Caribbean, Fleming's home became a hotel in 1995. Today, following a two-year renovation, it reemerges with eleven new cottages, six suites extending over a lagoon, and an activities program helmed by Jamaican Olympic triathlete Iona Wynter. *Rooms from \$536. 876-975-3354.*

THE BAR

Lani Kai, New York

BECAUSE: It's Trader Vic's for the '10s. Julie Reiner, the Hawaiian-born cocktail maven behind Brooklyn's cult favorite Clover Club, has unveiled her highly anticipated SoHo spot. Named for one of Honolulu's most beautiful beaches, **Lani Kai** serves tuna *poke* and pupu platters along with Reiner's signature sours, fizzes, and swizzles (sour concoctions churned with swizzle sticks). The new bar also utilizes tropical fruits and herbs in drinks like Leilani's Fizz, made with lemongrass syrup and muddled lychee. *646-596-8778. EIMEAR LYNCH*
