

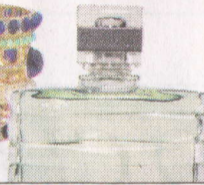

CARIBBEAN SHIPSHAPE

Three just-unveiled beachfront destinations to keep you warm this winter



ST. REGIS BAHIA BEACH

LOCATION: Set on 500 wildlife-filled acres a half-hour drive from San Juan, Puerto Rico, it overlooks the crystalline Caribbean. It's close to the El Yunque jungle.

LAYOUT: The former coconut plantation is now a 139-room resort with a massive spa, 18-hole golf course by Robert Trent Jones and a Euro-Latino Jean-Georges Vongerichten restaurant. **BONUS:** A private 2-mile-long beach and clubby library filled with art and culture tomes. Adventure types can opt for hiking, kayaking and bird-watching in El Yunque itself. *from \$599 a night, stregis.com*



GOLDENEYE

LOCATION: A 52-acre estate on Jamaica's classically chic northern coast where James Bond creator Ian Fleming penned all 14 Bond novels. **LAYOUT:** A two-year restoration has revived the estate's 007-era glamour. Fleming's original three-bedroom villa has been expanded to include a pair of pool-front villas. **BONUS:** Six Lagoon Suites practically float on water and include their own private docks for easy Bond-worthy getaways. *from \$536 a night, goldeneye.com*



TAMARIND COVE

LOCATION: On a slice of powdery beachfront on Barbados's west coast. **LAYOUT:** The Tamarind's pastel decor has been traded in for an earth-toned, contemporary design that marks its 104 rooms and suites. Outside, modular furniture and towering palms accent the pool. **BONUS:** Two new restaurants including a late-night pool-side tapas lounge. The on-site AQUA School offers complimentary lessons in kayaking, windsurfing, snorkeling and water-skiing. *from \$234 a night, www.tamarindbarbados.com*
